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# Coordination Needs

## A priority roadmap for the American Health Information Community:

- Will be developed to describe when areas and issues will be considered
- Allow AHIC workgroups to focus on their identified priorities and issues, but do so in a coordinated fashion
- Inform next steps for the different processes of the national agenda including “use cases” that detail needs for:
  - architecture
  - data harmonization
  - confidentiality and security
  - certification
  - policy consideration

# Status

Many priorities expressed by AHIC workgroups and others

- Not all issues can be addressed at one time
- There is overlap in the different priorities and there are relationships between different priorities
- Need to avoid “stovepipe” activities where there are opportunities to share and connect
- Need to address process “gaps” with the Health Information Technology Standards Panel and the Certification Commission for Health Information Technology

# Priorities and Use Cases

- Three use cases from the last cycle and one new:
  - EHR – Lab results
  - CE – Registration and medication history
  - Biosurveillance – Connecting clinical care data to public health
  - Emergency Responder EHR
- Develop a coordinating structure for future use cases with three high level perspectives:
  - Consumer Perspective
  - Provider Perspective
  - Secondary Use Perspective
- Put the existing use cases into this structure and develop the second round of use cases through extension into it
- As much as possible adhere to the priorities of the AHIC workgroups while leveraging activities across them

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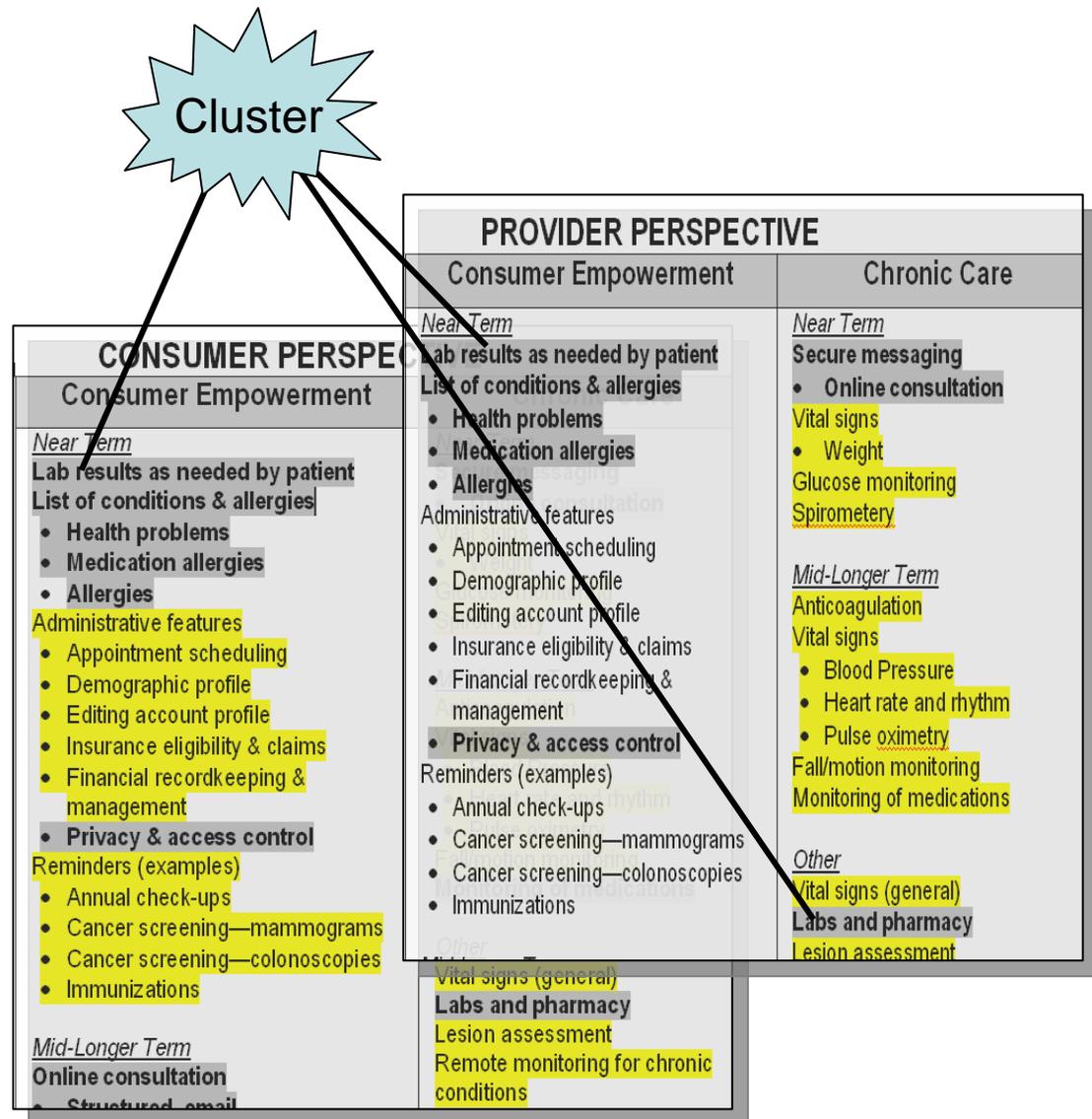

# Clustering across Workgroups and Perspectives

Cluster:

Priorities that relate to, or depend on, each other

Clustered items may influence the importance of the priorities



# Work Group Issues

- Common issues across workgroups
  - Business case
  - Work flow
  - Legal
  - Privacy, confidentiality and security
- Specific issues related to priority areas
  - Regulatory barriers for provider and patient access to lab results
  - EHR, PHR, remote care monitoring, and case reporting integration in work flow
  - Need for clear policy and practices for secondary uses of clinical data

- Initiate development of the next round of use cases
  - Two steps of public comment during use case development
- Workgroups continue to address important issues for their broad charges
- Develop high level roadmap for infrastructure development and AHIC activities
